Located in the southwest of Germany, Heidelberg is an international center for science and the economy but also a very historic and romantic city filled with philosophers and poets. The oldest German university is located in Heidelberg and the local culture is defined by the city's status as a university town.

The European Study Center is housed in a beautiful art nouveau building which is located in a quiet, safe residential area of Heidelberg. Listed as a national monument, the campus includes a scenic inner courtyard and garden and is close to the historic city center.




Centrally Located

Many cultural excursions are built into this study abroad program and students are encouraged to experience European culture on their own during their free time. In order to make sure students have ample time to explore Europe, class will only be held Monday-Thursday at the European Study Center. Heidelberg is centrally located in Western Europe and an optimal starting point for students to affordably travel to other major cities on their own.

Just 4-5 hours away: Paris, Amsterdam, Munich, Brussels and Zurich

Just 6-8 hours away: London, Prague, Vienna and Milan



Academic Program

All courses are taught in English and have been designed especially for this study abroad program. Courses will be taught by faculty from the US or local adjunct faculty at the European Study Center or by local faculty at the SRH University Heidelberg. Additionally, students have the option to take a German language course.

Coursework combines lectures and discussions with a variety of on-site visits to European political and economic institutions, German and multinational corporations, and historical and cultural points of interest. Assignments are designed to motivate students through experiential learning and provide a unique and enriching study abroad experience.

On-site Team

The European Study Center team is comprised of bi-lingual professionals who are native to Germany and the United States and who have years of experience working in the field of international education. This means there is always someone very knowledgeable right around the corner to help. Someone from our team always accompanies the study abroad group on field trips and excursions. Our first priority is for every student to have a positive experience which is academically sound and allows them to discover themselves and the world around them.

Cultural Excursions

To ensure that every student is able to make the most of his/her time in Heidelberg, numerous excursions have been built into the academic program and are included in the program cost. These include, for example, but are not limited to:

- 3-day trip to Berlin incl. tour of the Berlin Wall Museum, the Jewish Museum, the Reichstag and much more
- Guided walking tour of Heidelberg
- Entrance to the Heidelberg Castle
- Guided tour of the Hambach Castle
- Day trip to Stuttgart incl. a visit to a local company and a guided tour at the Mercedes-Benz Museum
- Train trip to Frankfurt to visit the German Stock Exchange and the European Central Bank or the German Bundesbank and the Money Museum
- Guided walking tour of Worms
- Day trip to Strasbourg, France for a guided tour of the city and a visit to either the Council of Europe or European Parliament
- Professional visit to the John Deere plant in Mannheim
- Visit to Neustadt an der Weinstrasse with a visit to a winery incl. wine tasting
